

# 'TRAVEL & STUDY ABROAD' CONTEST RULES AND DISCLAIMER ARTICLES.

## Contest Overview (non-binding summary)

This contest is organised by Student Aid NV and is open to eligible full-time tertiary education students aged 18–31. Participation is free. The contest runs until 31 July 2026. Winners are selected based on a tie-breaker question and may receive travel, leisure or media-related prizes as described below.

### Art. 1 - Set-up & organizer.

1.1 This INNERDREAMS "TRAVEL & STUDY ABROAD Contest" is free and open to all, hereinafter referred to as "contest". A French or Dutch version of these Contest Rules may be obtained upon written request via email.

1.2 The organizer is Student Aid N.V., Bruiloftstraat 127, B-9050 Ghent, Belgium. Hereinafter referred to as "Student Aid" or "Organizer".

1.3 Participation in the contest shall be deemed an unconditional full acceptance of the contest rules as well as a warranty that the participant meets all the eligibility requirements set forth herein. In addition, participants agree to accept the decisions of Student Aid, as final, subject to applicable law as it relates to the content. The contest is subject to all applicable international, European, and local laws. No further appeal is possible.

1.4 By participating, you agree to changes or additions to these Contest rules, if deemed necessary by the Organizer.

1.5 The closing date of this contest is July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026.

### Art. 2 - Participation.

2.1 No purchase is necessary to enter or win.

2.2 Participants shall enter the Contest by duly completing and submitting the entry form via the online link made available on the Contest website.

2.3 Prizes are restricted to full-time students of tertiary education between 18 and 31 years old. To be eligible for a prize, each entry must fully comply with all applicable requirements, rules, and specifications set out in these Terms and Conditions. The Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to disqualify any entry that is incomplete, inaccurate, or otherwise fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions. The Organizer reserves the right to request reasonable proof of student status and age prior to awarding a prize.

2.4 A participant as described in art. 2.3 is eligible for a prize if, before the closing date as defined in art. 1.5:

- All survey questions are answered, **and**
- The tiebreaker (bonus) question is answered, **and**
- Our Terms and conditions have been accepted.

2.5 In the case of multiple submitted forms by the same participant, the first completed form is valid. Using different e-mail addresses for multiple entries of the same participant is prohibited. Participants attempting this may be disqualified at the sole discretion of Student Aid.

2.6 Family members and their staff of "the Organiser and Partners" can participate but cannot win prizes. For the purpose of this article, 'family members' refers to first-degree relatives.

### Art. 3 - Contest run and prize selection.

3.1 The contest runs until the closing date (cf. art. 1.5).

3.2 The contest has a bonus question, which is as follows:

How many unique, eligible students will take part, **in total, across** all ISIC surveys hosted on [www.innerdreams.eu](http://www.innerdreams.eu) before they close at midnight on 31/07/2026? The correct answer will be determined objectively based on system records maintained by the Organizer.

3.3 The winners of this contest will be the participants, described in art. 2.4, who come closest to finding the correct answer to the tiebreaker question in art. 3.2. They will be ranked based on the absolute difference between their answer and the correct answer. In case of a draw, the Organizer will provide equal prizes or prizes of equivalent value, and the next winner will be moved one step down in the ranking. Winners are responsible for valid passports, visas, insurance and travel documents.

3.4 Contest prizes are as follows. All prizes described in this article will be awarded after the closing date.

#### 3.4.1 The Grand prize (1<sup>st</sup> place)

The first-ranked eligible participant-winner (cf. art. 3.3) receives a five-day ISIC Student New York City Break for two students in February 2027, including:

- Direct round-trip flight from Brussels Airport (BRU) to New York John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) with Brussels Airlines or a Star Alliance Partner.
- A four-night stay in a centrally located hotel in New York City (standard room, double occupancy);
- A unique half-day guided experience in New York City, as determined by the Organizer and/or its partners.

The exact travel dates, itinerary, accommodation, and other practical details will be determined by Student Aid in collaboration with its partners and are subject to availability and the applicable conditions of the travel service providers.

#### 3.4.2 Prizes for participants ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> place

Extra prizes are available for up to four eligible participant-winners ranked immediately after the grand-prize winner (i.e. ranks 2 to 5), and consist of the following prize pool:

- Two winners will each receive one "Duo VIP ticket for Tomorrowland Summer 2027 or 2028";
- Two winners will each receive a one-week stay for two people at the International Surf Village near Bilbao in Spain's Basque Country, including full board (details and dates to be determined by the Organizer and/or its partners).

These extra prizes will be allocated based on ranking: the highest-ranked participant in this group chooses from the available extra prizes, followed by the next highest-ranked participant, and so on, until all such extra prizes have been allocated. Once all extra prizes listed above have been allocated, any remaining participants ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> will not receive an extra prize under this article.

#### 3.4.3 Prizes for participants ranked 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place

Each eligible participant-winner ranked from 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place (cf. art. 3.3) receives:

- One year of complimentary professional access to leading AI assistants (specific tools, scope of "professional access" and conditions to be determined by the Organizer and/or its partners); or
- A cinema pass for free access for 1 year or 52 cinema tickets with a validity of one year.

3.5 Student Aid shall have the right to ask additional information, such as a picture and/or a (voice) statement about the contest, from any of the winners.

3.6 Student Aid, anyone acting on behalf of Student Aid, or its respective licensees, successors and assigns, shall have the right, where permitted by law, to print, publish, broadcast, distribute, and use in any media now known or here after developed, in perpetuity and throughout the world, without limitation, your entry, name, portrait, picture, voice, likeness, image, statements about the contest, and biographical information for news, publicity, information, trade, advertising, public relations, and promotional purposes without any further compensation, notice, review, or consent.

### Art. 4 - Additional info.

4.1 Winners will be notified by email, after the contest closes, within a reasonable period following the closing date using the email address entered by participants in the contest questionnaire. There will be no other communication about the competition or the awarding of prizes, whether by telephone or in writing. Organizer is not responsible for any technical or other problems related to this competition, which happened beyond its control or are caused by elements that cannot be controlled by Student Aid. It is the responsibility of each participant to ensure that their software and hardware are protected and functioning properly. Organizer cannot be held liable if the competition cannot take place due to force majeure or if its

modalities must be adjusted, regardless of the reason for such adjustment. In the event of abuse, deception, or fraud, Student Aid expressly reserves the right to exclude any participant(s) from any further participation.

4.2 Winners must claim the prize within 45 calendar days from the time award notification was sent and collect their prize within 90 calendar days. If not, prize may be forfeited. Organiser shall have no liability for a winner's failure to receive notices due to winners' spam, junk e-mail or other security settings or for winners' provision of incorrect or otherwise non-functioning contact information. There will be no communication with non-winners.

4.3 No cash or other prize substitution is permitted. All prize-related extra expenses shall be the sole responsibility of the winner. No substitution of prize or transfer/assignment of prize to others or request for the cash equivalent by winners is permitted.

4.4 Prizes are non-transferable unless expressly authorised by the Organiser in writing.

4.5 The Organizer reserves the right to implement the contest in a different way in countries where local regulations or laws prevents the executions as described above.

## **Art. 5 – Privacy and Disclaimer**

### 5.1 Storage and removal of personal data

All personal data of Innerdreams® participants is stored in a database controlled by Student Aid NV, B-9050 Ghent, Bruiloftstraat 127. The database is hosted in a data center located in the EU. Personal data is processed on the legal basis of consent and, where applicable, legitimate interest. Personal data of participants to a contest related to a questionnaire will be deleted from our database as soon as the contest ends, unless participants are prize winners or participants opted in for the Social Samba® ambassador's platform. Personal data of prize winners will be removed from our database after all prizes have been redeemed. In case prize winners haven't shown up to claim their prizes within 6 months after the end of a contest, all personal data of the prize winners will be deleted.

### 5.2 Transfer of personal data

A participant's personal data will only be transferred to external organisations where the participant has opted in to a specific call to action requiring such transfer (e.g. enrolment in a loyalty programme). Without explicit consent, no personal data will be shared with any external organisation.

Participants personal data will only be transferred to a partner in another country to accommodate the redemption of local prizes. Transfers outside the European Economic Area (EEA) will only occur with appropriate safeguards in place.

### 5.3 Rights of participants

In compliance with GDPR regulation Article 13, paragraph 2b, any data subject has the right to revoke consent to store personal data, to request rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing concerning the data subject or to object to processing as well as the right to data portability.

Participants requesting the erasure of their personal data will no longer be eligible to win prizes nor will they be able to join the Social Samba ambassadors' platform.

These Contest Rules are governed by Belgian law. Any disputes shall fall under the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent courts of Belgium.
